



Sixth Consultative Conference of CPC(M-L) and Revolutionary Rally

VIGOROUS DEFENCE OF THE PURITY OF MARXISM-LENINISM AND THE PRINCIPLES OF PROLETARIAN INTERNATIONALISM



The Sixth Consultative Conference of the Communist Party of Canada (Marxist-Leninist) on Proletarian Strategy and Programme of Action held its final proceedings in Montreal on March 31, the ninth anniversary of the founding of the Party, in a militant revolutionary atmosphere, followed by a Revolutionary Rally in defence of the purity of Marxism-Leninism and the principles of proletarian internationalism. Throughout the day's proceedings, 1,500 people participated in these revolutionary events.

The auditorium was decorated with revolutionary slogans and banners and dozens of red flags emblazoned with CPC(M-L) in gold letters. Above the rostrum were the revolutionary slogans: **Bohhevize the Party, Prepare for the Coming Revolutionary Storms!**, as well as portraits of the leaders of the international proletariat — Marx, Engels, Lenin and Stalin — a large hammer and sickle and a banner reading Sixth Consultative Conference of the Communist Party of Canada (Marxist-Leninist). Along one wall, large banners bore the revolutionary slogans: **Uphold Marxism-Leninism and Proletarian Internationalism and Workers of All Countries, Unite!** A large colour painting, measuring 25 feet by 9 feet, prepared by the Canadian Cultural Workers' Committee for the Conference, with the slogan **El Marxismo-Leninismo Vencerá!** (Marxism-Leninism Will Win!) was also on the wall.

The first portion of the day's programme consisted of the concluding session of the Sixth Consultative Conference, which had begun its proceedings on March 26. In the earlier sessions of the Conference, the crucial question of bolshevizing the Party was taken up and discussed by the delegates. Comrade Bains delivered an important speech in which this and other important questions facing the Party, the revolutionary forces in Canada, and the International Marxist-Leninist Communist Movement were dealt with.

The second portion of the day's programme was the Revolutionary Rally in defence of the purity of Marxism-Leninism and the principles of proletarian internationalism, in celebration of the ninth anniversary of the founding of CPC(M-L). The Party invited the fraternal Marxist-Leninist parties and organizations to participate in the rally so that the proletarian and progressive forces in Canada could hear the voice of Marxism-Leninism in order to smash the imperialist and social-imperialist

counter-revolutionary propaganda aimed at sowing confusion as to what is Marxism-Leninism, what is genuine socialism, that "socialism doesn't work", and so on. Of great historic significance in this regard was the presence at the Conference and rally of a delegation of the Central Committee of the Party of Labour of Albania, the first ever such delegation to visit Canada. This great historic visit has served to further strengthen the developing fraternal unity between the genuine Marxist-Leninist and revolutionary forces of Canada and the Albanian communists and revolutionary forces.

The arrival of the delegation of the Central Committee of the Party of Labour of Albania to the auditorium prior to the start of the formal programme, was a scene of great revolutionary excitement. The delegation, comprised of Comrade Xhelli Gjoni, member of the Central Committee of the PLA and leader of the delegation, Comrade Harila Pajorigji, Scientific Secretary of the Institute of Marxist-Leninist Studies under the Central Committee of the PLA, and Comrade Egerem Mete, the interpreter, who is a scientific worker at the Institute of Marxist-Leninist Studies, was greeted by a group of young pioneers who presented the Albanian comrades with a bouquet of flowers. The Albanian comrades embraced and kissed the children and warmly thanked them for their greeting. The PLA delegation was also met by a representative of the Montreal Branch of CPC(M-L) who welcomed them to Montreal, and to the final session of the Consultative Conference.

At 11:00 a.m., Comrade Harila Bains, Chairman of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of Canada (Marxist-Leninist), mounted the rostrum. The 1,500 delegates, Party activists and friends of the Party rose to their feet and gave Comrade Bains a thunderous standing ovation of several minutes' duration. On behalf of the Central Committee of the Party, Comrade Bains formally opened the final session of the Sixth Consultative Conference. He indicated that it was a public session which would bring to a close the Conference which had begun on March 26. Comrade Bains said that the Party is extremely honoured by the attendance at the Conference of the various Marxist-Leninist parties and organizations from around the world, including amongst them the delegation from the Central Committee of the Party of Labour of Albania.

The audience broke into thunderous applause when the delegation of the Party of Labour of Albania was introduced to the

public session of the Conference. The fraternal comrades from the Party of Labour of Albania were welcomed to the podium and warmly embraced by Comrade Bains. The standing ovation and shouts of "Ever Hoxha! Ever Hoxha! Marxism-Leninism! Marxism-Leninism!" continued for several minutes. Comrade Harila Bains and Comrade Xhelli Gjoni, Member of the CC of the PLA, joined hands and raised them high, symbolizing the friendship and deep ties between the two parties based on Marxism-Leninism and the principles of proletarian internationalism.

Comrade Bains then introduced the delegations of the other fraternal Marxist-Leninist parties and organizations participating in the Sixth Consultative Conference of CPC(M-L). One by one, the delegations from the Revolutionary Communist Party of Britain (Marxist-Leninist), the Workers' Communist Party of France, the Communist Party of India (Marxist-Leninist), the Workers and Peasants' Communist Party of Iran, the Communist Party of Italy (Marxist-Leninist), the Communist Party of Portugal (Reconstructed), the National Liberation Movement of Trinidad (Trinidad and Tobago), the Central Organization of U.S. Marxist-Leninists, the Revolutionary Communist Party of Chile, and the Bandera Roja Party of Venezuela were introduced and warmly embraced by Comrade Bains. The audience remained standing during the introduction of the fraternal Marxist-Leninist parties and organizations, enthusiastically greeting each delegation with stormy applause and clenched fist salutes. As a sign of the heartfelt appreciation by CPC(M-L) for the participation of the fraternal Marxist-Leninist parties and organizations in the Sixth Consultative Conference, CPC(M-L) presented a sign in honour of the fraternal Marxist-Leninist parties and organizations, entitled: **You Do Us a Great Honour.** (This song is reproduced on page 4 of this issue).

The revolutionary sentiments of the song were greeted with the sustained applause of the audience and the fraternal delegates. At 11:28, Comrade Bains announced that the programme for the day's activities had been changed and that the afternoon sessions of the Conference would be devoted to an important presentation by the delegation of the CC of the PLA on three key questions: 1) problems of socialist construction in Albania, 2) the centenary of the birth of J.V. Stalin, and 3) Chinese revisionism and "Mao Zedong Thought".

Comrade Bains warmly thanked the delegation of the PLA for accepting the invitation of the CC of CPC(M-L) to present the views of the PLA on these matters of great importance.

Comrade Bains then delivered an important address on the question of Proletarian Strategy and Programme of Action, summing up many of the discussions which had taken place on various questions during the Sixth Consultative Conference, especially in regard to the vital task of bolshevizing the Party. The speech concluded with an extensive quotation from the work of Comrade Ever Hoxha, *Imperialism and the Revolution*. Comrade Bains pointed out that our Party estimates this work, which provides the Marxist-Leninist line on all important questions, as the most important since the time of Stalin and that our Party has taken up the task of seriously studying this work and widely popularizing it. At the conclusion of the speech by Comrade Bains, the audience and the fraternal comrades rose together in a standing ovation. The representative of the CC of the PLA clasped Comrade Bains' hand and raised it high in a salute to the victory of Marxism-Leninism.

Between the morning and afternoon sessions, those attending the Sixth Consultative Conference and the Revolutionary Rally had the opportunity to study the Albanian photo exhibition with and about Albania, performed by the Canadian Cultural Workers' Committee, including the *Song of the Seventh Congress, Ever Hoxha O Tunjajeta, Oh Albania, Red Star that Burns Bright, O Jeunesse Belle Jeunesse and Pick in One Hand and Rifle in the Other*. Comrade Bains, the delegation of the PLA, and the delegations of the other fraternal Marxist-Leninist parties and organizations

again took their places on the rostrum at 2:30 p.m. Comrade Bains introduced Comrade Xhelli Gjoni and invited him to present his speech. The audience vigorously applauded with shouts of Bravo! and whistles, raised fists to salute the Albanian comrades, and shouts of "PLAI PLAI". The enthusiastic ovation continued for more than five minutes.

Comrade Gjoni thanked CPC(M-L) for inviting the delegation to participate in the Sixth Consultative Conference and to present the views of the PLA to the Conference. Comrade Gjoni then spoke in detail on the problems of socialist construction in Albania and the successes the Albanian people had achieved by firmly adhering to Marxism-Leninism and proletarian internationalism and by paying attention to the objective laws of socialist construction elaborated by Lenin and Stalin. Comrade Gjoni also dealt with the question of the life and work of J.V. Stalin. Comrade Gjoni read the decision of the CC of the PLA on the celebration of the 100th anniversary of the birth of J.V. Stalin (See PCDN, Vol. 9, No. 73, March 26, 1979) and enumerated many of the immortal contributions of J.V. Stalin to the triumph of the revolution and socialism. Comrade Gjoni pointed out that some people today are raising that the present leaders of Soviet social-imperialism have "sympathy" for Stalin, but that this is a fraud. Comrade Gjoni pointed out that the revisionism of Brezhnev is the same as the revisionism of Khrushchov, only more cunning. The participants in the Conference listened attentively to the speech of Comrade Gjoni and on several occasions burst into vigorous applause.

During the break between the afternoon sessions, Comrade Bains led the delegations of the PLA and the delegations of the other fraternal Marxist-Leninist parties and organizations to view the Albanian photo exhibition at the back of the hall. As the delegation of the PLA made its way around the exhibition, they were surrounded by well-wishers. Comrade Gjoni and the other Albanian comrades warmly shook hands with the progressive people at the Conference. They spoke with several Albanian residents of Canada and had discussions with many revolutionary workers and students. One youth told Comrade Gjoni of the terrible life of the youth under monopoly capitalism. Comrade Gjoni told the young man about the life of the youth in Albania and told the youth that he should treasure the genuine Marxist-Leninist parties because

it is only with such parties that the proletariat and people, including the youth, can have a bright future. Moved by the warmth and advice of Comrade Gjoni, the youth firmly shook the comrade's hand and told him: "You represent the new man for us." In all of his discussions, Comrade Gjoni emphasized the absolute necessity for the Marxist-Leninist Party. He pointed out that man has made many inventions and scientific discoveries, such as spacecraft and going to the moon, but that the greatest achievement was the one by Lenin, for it was Lenin who gave us the Party organization.

At 4:30 p.m., Comrade Bains and the delegations of the fraternal Marxist-Leninist parties and organizations returned to the rostrum amidst thunderous applause. Comrade Bains pointed out that CPC(M-L) had made a serious mistake in contributing to the mythification of Mao Zedong and the anti-Marxist-Leninist "Mao Zedong Thought", but that by vigorously defending the purity of Marxism-Leninism and the principles of proletarian internationalism, the Party was able to topple Mao Zedong and the anti-Marxist-Leninist "Mao Zedong Thought" from its unwarranted pedestal at the Third Plenum of the CC of CPC(M-L). Comrade Bains then called upon Comrade Gjoni to deliver the portion of his speech devoted to the reactionary, anti-Marxist-Leninist essence of "Mao Zedong Thought". Comrade Gjoni applauded the self-criticism of CPC(M-L), pointing out that a serious revolutionary Party is one which is most self-critical. Comrade Gjoni stressed that the PLA considers CPC(M-L) a serious Party. The audience responded to this statement with a loud and prolonged standing ovation. Comrade Gjoni then elaborated the experience of the Albanians with the Chinese revisionists, exposing in detail how "Mao Zedong Thought" is at odds with Marxism-Leninism on all the vital questions. Those attending the Conference listened very attentively to the views of the PLA and on several occasions interrupted Comrade Gjoni's speech with enthusiastic applause. At the end of the speech, the delegation of the PLA was vigorously applauded once again, with a standing ovation, cheers and protracted clapping and applause.

At 6:30 p.m., Comrade Harila Bains opened the Revolutionary Rally in defence of Marxism-Leninism and proletarian internationalism to celebrate the ninth anniversary of the founding of the Communist Party of Canada (Marxist-Leninist).

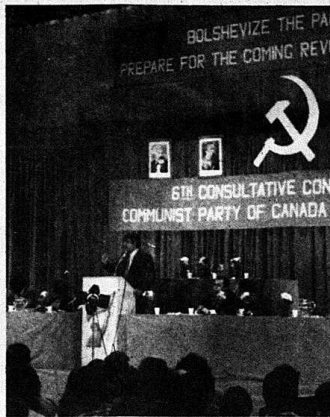

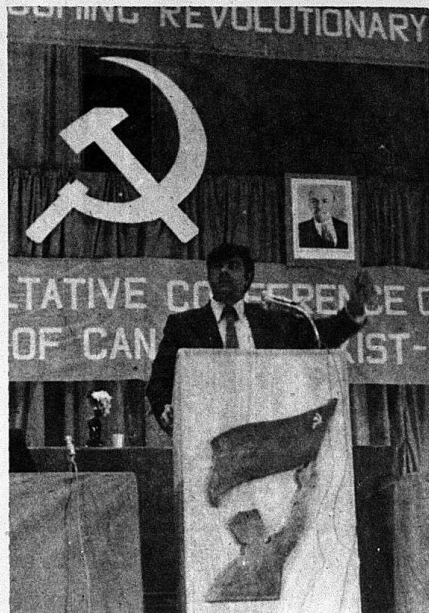

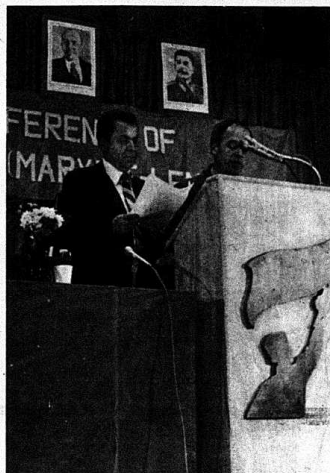

Vigorous defence of the purity of Marxism-Leninism and the principles of proletarian internationalism . . . from page 1

Leninist) in Montreal on March 31, 1970. Comrade Bains stated, "Nine years ago on this day, the Communist Party of Canada (Marxist-Leninist) was founded." The entire crowd of 1,500 people rose to its feet with thunderous applause that lasted for more than 10 minutes. Shouts of Long Live the Communist Party of Canada (Marxist-Leninist) rang out time and again. In brief remarks, Comrade Bains summed up the revolutionary history of the Party, always loyal to Marxism-Leninism and proletarian internationalism, including the struggle our Party has waged against Chinese revisionism and the counter-revolutionary interference of the Chinese revisionists in Canada. Comrade Bains pointed out that although the imperialists, social-imperialists and the revisionists and opportunists of all hues have made many attempts to liquidate our Party, our Party cannot be liquidated because it has the red spine of Marxism-Leninism. Comrade Bains hailed the bilateral and multilateral exchanges which have taken place between our Party and fraternal Marxist-Leninist parties and organizations, and pointed out that these exchanges have assisted us tremendously to carry out our work on the basis of Marxism-Leninism and proletarian internationalism. He expressed our deepest gratitude to the fraternal Marxist-Leninist parties and organizations for coming to share this important occasion with us. On behalf of the CC of CPC(M-L), Comrade Bains expressed our deepest respect for the PLA and its leadership and for the work they have done in defence of Marxism-Leninism and proletarian internationalism. Comrade Bains then invited the representatives of the fraternal Marxist-Leninist parties and organizations to address the rally. As well, messages from several fraternal Marxist-Leninist parties which were unable to attend the rally were read. The fraternal Marxist-Leninist parties and organizations addressing the rally or sending messages of greetings included the Banda-

Roja Party of Venezuela, the Communist Party of Spain (Marxist-Leninist), the Central Organization of U.S. Marxist-Leninists, the National Liberation Movement of Trinidad (Trinidad and Tobago), the Communist Party of Porgual (Reconstructed), the Communist Party of Italy (Marxist-Leninist), the Workers' and Peasants' Communist Party of Iran, the Communist Party of India (Marxist-Leninist), the Communist Party of Germany (Marxist-Leninist), the Workers' Communist Party of France, the Communist Party of Denmark (Marxist-Leninist), the Revolutionary Communist Party of Chile, the Revolutionary Communist Party of Britain (Marxist-Leninist), and the Party of Labour of Albania. Speaking on behalf of the CC of the PLA, Comrade Xhelli Gjoni pointed out that in socialist Albania, the Canadian proletariat and people have a sincere friend, Comrade Gjoni concluded his message of greetings with the slogans: Long Live Marxism-Leninism! Long Live Proletarian Internationalism! Long Live the Friendship between Our Two Parties Based on Marxism-Leninism! Long Live the Communist Party of Canada (Marxist-Leninist)! Long Live the Canadian People! The messages of greetings were responded to with profound joy and tumultuous applause. Comrade Bains and Comrade Gjoni embraced each other and held each other's hand high in the air while comrades and friends vigorously shouted "Ever Hoxha! Ever Hoxha!, Marxism-Leninism! Marxism-Leninism!" over and over again. When Comrade Bains announced the beginning of the cultural programme, from the back of the hall were immediately heard the drums of the revolutionary Bhanga dancers, and soon their red flags were waving in the air. The Bhanga came to a climax when portraits of Marx, Engels, Lenin and Stalin were raised high and slogans of Glory to Marxism-Leninism!, Long Live Comrade Ever Hoxha!, Long Live the PLA! and 1979 Year of Stalin! were shouted. The

Canadian Cultural Workers' Committee presented numerous songs and poems celebrating the Party and Marxism-Leninism, including *L'avenir dans notre Parti, Here's the Rose - Now Dance!, From Stalin We Learn, Inevitable Struggle's Broken Out*, and a poem commemorating the 55th anniversary of the death of Comrade Lenin. The West Indian cultural group presented two revolutionary calypsos, *Albania Bastion of Socialism and World Revolution and Forward!* The Iranian cultural group presented a song commemorating the martyrs who fought against the Shah and imperialism and the rendition in Persian of *Whirlwinds of Danger (La Varsovienne)*. All of the fraternal delegations, as well as the entire crowd, were deeply moved by the revolutionary cultural presentations. After each performance, the Albanian comrades left the rostrum to greet each of the cultural performers and express their joy at the lively revolutionary culture. The delegation of the PLA then greeted a group of young pioneers, who led the audience in shouting "Ever Hoxha! Ever Hoxha!" Comrade Bains then announced that the comrades from the fraternal Marxist-Leninist parties and organizations had asked to greet the comrades and friends at the Revolutionary Rally. As the fraternal comrades went amongst the crowd at the rally shaking hands, there was constant applause and shouting of slogans. The Revolutionary Rally concluded with the singing of the Internationale, but a festive revolutionary carnival continued for several hours. The singing of the revolutionary songs and the waving of red flags filled the hall. At 11:30 p.m., Comrade Bains returned to the rostrum amidst enthusiastic applause to make some concluding remarks to the Revolutionary Rally. Comrade Bains pointed out the importance of the Sixth Consultative Conference in ushering in new responsibilities for the Party to take up on the questions of the bolshevization of the Party and proletarian internationalism. Comrade Bains dealt with the question of the unity of the International Marxist-Leninist Communist Movement and pointed out that there cannot be two lines in the International Marxist-Leninist Communist Movement any more than there can be two lines within a single Marxist-Leninist Party. Comrade Bains pointed out that the victories of the Party in carrying out its proletarian internationalist duty were not the work of one individual or of many individuals, but the work of the class, which had given birth to the Party, and which had given birth to the Party would expressed confidence that the Party would continue to carry out its duties with honour. At the end of Comrade Bains' speech, the slogans of Long Live CPC(M-L), Long Live the Party of Labour of Albania!, Glory to Marxism-Leninism! and Workers of All Countries, Unite! were shouted over and over again. The jubilant revolutionary carnival continued until the early hours of the morning.
