

IPSG MEETING: FEDERAL ELECTIONS  
AND  
NATIONAL MINORITIES.

We, the national minorities in Canada and Quebec have been told that we will be "secure" only if we keep out of progressive politics but if we decide to support revolutionary organization in Canada or in Afro-Asian countries or in any way express progressive political thinking we are labelled "security risk."
