On april 12, the Los Angeles Work Group dissolved itself. The organization went through a split primarily due to dogmatism in 1976. For some time now we have been a very small unit without the intention of rebuilding an organization on our own. All members have a high degree of unity with the OCIC. All members support the dissolution as a positive step. The dissolution will allow us a broader division of labor in our efforts to build an ideological center.
