

ANTI-IMPERIALIST STORM IN CANADIAN PRISONS

NOVA SCOTIA

ELECTION SHAM

In the last ten years, Nova Scotia has been completely sold out to foreign monopoly capitalist interests by the traitor comprador class. Foreign monopolies, mainly U.S. imperialists, have occupied the province and are exploiting the people, directly and indirectly—indirectly through tax concessions and other financial benefits paid to the monopolies by the provincial government, directly through the low wages existing in the province.

Recently the U.S. monopolies have accelerated the exploitation of Nova Scotia's natural resources and are discovering the "benefits" of manufacturing consumer goods on the low wage scale and importing them to the U.S. This has resulted in so-called "strengthening trade ties" between U.S. monopolies and their branches in the Maritimes.

As that mouthpiece of U.S. imperialism, the Toronto *Globe and Mail*, put it last year: Nova Scotia is not a labour stronghold, the people not being unionized. The pay scales are also wonderfully low. \$1.65 for men over 18, and 90 cents for women over 18. 90 cents for men under 18 and 85 cents for women under 18.

Take a look at some of these foreign monopolies: Michelin, a French monopoly which comes from a country riddled with labour unrest. The provincial government has provided this company with \$50,000,000 in free land and other benefits from the people of Nova Scotia. Both and Acadia fisheries, two infamous companies who are trying to deny the workers the right to organize in the union of their choice. Both of these companies are foreign-owned. Acadia says they "are owned by an o-o-o-ld English family", and both is owned by the American imperialists. There is also Hawker-Sidley, another o-o-o-ld English family with their interests in Stellarton and Halifax. It is not so long since these people were prepared to sell the people of Cape Breton in order to make a profit.

Just recently the provincial government had an offer from a group of American financiers to buy hundreds of acres of land in the Northport area to

build a beef farm that would produce 20,000 head of beef a year. The U.S. imperialists wanted \$3,000,000 from the government. For the time being the provincial government has turned down the "generous" offer because the coming election would make further selling of the province unwise right now. After the election we can expect the government to renegotiate the whole Northport deal.

To win the election, the government has arranged with the union hacks that have negotiated with them to settle all strikes as soon as possible so that there will be relative calm in the province's labor problems in the next couple of months. At least Smith (in true lackey fashion) is keeping his fingers crossed.

The people are not deceived. The workers of the province have militantly resisted all the forms of labour legislation of the government whether it be federal or provincial. They have stood up and been found in "contempt of court" as an honour rather than as a disgrace. The disgrace is in the law of the bourgeoisie and their judicial system that exists to exploit the people and not to serve them. For this reason the courts are worthy of contempt. Workers of the maritimes have refused to be intimidated by the lackey police and have marched forward to trample all the anti-people rules and regulations underfoot. From time to time they have gone against the various labour misleaders. In the future, the workers will entirely push aside the muck of the imperialists.

The Nova Scotia people have no faith in elections. After each election, the situation does not improve. On the contrary, it becomes worse as the exploitation of the people intensifies. The people of Nova Scotia do not want to go to the polls every few years to vote for which lackey of the U.S. imperialists will oppress them now. The working class of Nova Scotia has realized that only by relying on its own initiative, defying all fascist rules and regulations and persevering in struggle will there be any hope for the working class and people of Nova Scotia in future.

EDMONTON COMRADES

FIGHT COURTS

Edmonton, October 6, 1970 -

The Alberta Human Rights Association has condemned the "stay of proceedings" passed by the Alberta Supreme Court on the case of Fred and Susan Herzog, Roger Tentry and Ian Walker as "intolerable".

The president of the association, Dr. John Packer, declared that the court had violated the rights of the four comrades by holding them in jail for three months and then not proceeding with a "fair hearing".

In order that the comrades not be able to further denounce the Supreme Court, the court refused to continue with the case last week. At the same time, the court could not drop the charges since then it would have to provide some excuse to explain why the four comrades had been held in jail for three months on \$25,000 and \$5,000 bails. In an attempt to get out of this dilemma, the judge passed a "stay of proceedings" which shoves the case aside without dropping the charges, subject to the stipulation that the four can be called to stand trial at any moment. This further shows the complete arbitrariness of fascist courts and for this the four comrades waged a bitter fight against the RCMP and the Edmonton City Police when they refused to "just leave the courtroom quietly" and instead condemned the Supreme Court for its actions. "We have been in prison for three months on phoney charges. This is typical fascist justice", shouted Fred Herzog as he fought off the attacks of the U.S.-lackey police.

Afro American Communists Arrested

Afro-American youth here have taken up the call of the American Communist Worker's Movement (Marxist-Leninist) to revolutionary youth and students to disseminate MAO TSEUNG THOUGHT widely to the broad masses and to "wage war of annihilation on the

Since January this year, a reign of terror against anti-imperialist fighters has been carried out by the lackey ruling class of Canada. Since Bill Shpilka and his five comrades first appeared in court in January for their attempts to carry out political discussion with the workers at Canon in Vancouver, more than 90 communists and their supporters have been arrested and/or jailed on trumped-up charges ranging from "causing a disturbance" and "assaulting police" to "defamatory libel" and "possessing a weapon offensive to public order".

The method of these arrests has in the main been as follows: try to stop a comrade from carrying out political agitation (through discussion with the masses, sale of newspapers, demonstrations, etc.) by the use of some arbitrary or concocted "rule" or "regulation" specially designed to deprive people of their democratic rights. When the comrade protests this attack on his democratic rights, he is then physically assaulted on the grounds that he is "trespassing" or "causing a disturbance". When the comrade fights back, reinforcements are called to attack him further on the grounds that he, (and not the lackey police or authorities) is guilty of "assault".

The same gangster method is used to arrest militant participants in demonstrations against U.S. imperialism. When the people protest and take militant action against the provocations of

various police agents (Zionists and other fascists, usually in the guise of press reporters), police come in on the side of the disrupters and arrest the people. A second method is for the political police themselves to harass demonstrators so viciously that the demonstrators must retaliate, thus giving the lackey political police their "excuse" to arrest the anti-imperialist fighters on trumped-up non-political charges. The third method is to engineer attacks (armed and otherwise) against the comrades. When they fight back, as Comrade Robert A. Cruise, leading spokesman of the Communist Party of Canada (Marxist-Leninist) fought back with a shotgun defending a communist bookstore in Hamilton against paid fascist goons, arrest the comrades for defending their democratic rights and the democratic rights of the Canadian people to resist oppression. The gangster logic can be summed up: ALL RIGHTS TO THE EXPLOITERS TO OPPRESS: NO RIGHTS FOR THE PEOPLE TO FIGHT BACK.

This is all in keeping with a set of directives issued by the U.S. Justice Department. An aide to this fascist department recently addressed a clandestinely organized conference of "Campus security forces" from the U.S. colleges held in Victoria, B.C. during the week of June 15 this year. Even the bourgeois press confessed that this fascist aide told the security forces in the clearest terms to "chase

DONG FENG CAPTAIN ADDRESSES NATIONAL DAY CELEBRATION OF PATRIOTIC CHINESE IN VANCOUVER

On Saturday, October 3rd, Vancouver was the scene of a warm celebration marking the 21st anniversary of the Founding of the Great People's Republic of China. The celebration, organized by the patriotic Chinese Ad Hoc Committee to Celebrate the 21st Anniversary of the People's Republic of China, was attended by more than 400 people, enthusiastic supporters of the People's Republic of China, including the crew members of the Dong Feng and patriotic Chinese from points throughout North America. The celebration began with everyone standing and singing THE EAST IS RED, THE CHINESE NATIONAL ANTHEM and THE CANADIAN NATIONAL ANTHEM. Throughout the evening the masses present paid tribute to the 21 years of monumental pro-

gress of the Chinese people with speeches, solidarity messages and revolutionary songs.

A representative of the Canada-China Friendship Association was the first to speak. She stated that it is China that is providing the powerful leadership today to the world's revolutionary peoples, that China is the Great Red Bastion of world revolution standing resolute and strong behind the cause of national liberation, militantly opposed to the number one enemy of the world's people, U.S. imperialism. She laid special emphasis on China's 21 years of progress unprecedented in world history, stating that by 1964 the Chinese working class had already broken the U.S. -

Peking, October 1st, 1970 - The great socialist China has advanced victoriously along the course charted by the great leader Chairman Mao for 21 years already. Filled with revolutionary pride, several hundred thousand army men and people in Peking jubilantly celebrate the first National Day in the 1970's in Tien An Men Square and wish Chairman Mao, the founder of the People's Republic of China, a long, long life! (A full page pictorial of the celebration is reproduced on page 4 of today's PEOPLE'S CANADA DAILY NEWS.)

Barry Commoner, a leading spokesman for fascist "science" in the United States and a close collaborator with the initiator of the present "pollution scare", President Nixon, was thoroughly denounced by revolutionary youth and students at McGill University in Montreal on October 1st. It's bogus "law and order" totally defeated, the McGill administration called the notorious Montreal "riot" squad against the students.

In a leaflet distributed for one week before October 1st, the Progressive Natural Sciences Study Group stated that the U.S. ruling class is attempting to conceal the main contradiction in society by trying to "unite the country to solve the pollution problem" and is organizing reactionary "conferences", "pickets", and "earth days" to further spread their lies. The pollution problem exists, the leaflet points out, because imperialism exists solely to produce profits by exploiting the world's people. Thus while imperialism says that "people and over-population are the cause of pollution", the facts show that in the People's Republic of China where political power is in the hands of the working class the "pollution problem" has already been solved in all major industrial centers. The bourgeoisie states that "in order to solve the pollution problem, the population must be reduced, i.e. mass extermination of "inferior" groups, and that the people must be brought "closer to nature". The bourgeoisie claim that people who live under starvation conditions cause less pollution than those who are more "affluent". As Dr. Wayne Davies puts it. "The

starving blacks in Mississippi... have the least destructive effect on the land" and "Blessed be the starving blacks of Mississippi with their outdoor privies, for they are ecologically sound." In other words, to solve pollution we must escalate the exploitation of the working people." These type of people are not wanted in Quebec, the students declared and he should get out.

On October 1st groups of students gathered and, led by the members of the Progressive Natural Sciences Study Group, they held discussions on the issues involved. In the evening, as Commoner was nervously introduced by the academic hacks of McGill University, the students rose up, took over the microphone and denounced this agent of U.S. imperialism and told him to get out of Quebec. Plainclothes detectives and various toughs planted throughout the audience rose to attack the revolutionary students and defend the interests of U.S. imperialism at McGill. The slogans "Down with fascist science!" "Down with Barry Commoner!" and "Yankee go home!" shook the hall. The administration hacks ran to call the Montreal riot squad which arrived with all its combat gear to support the right against the left.

This action has put the McGill Administration on notice that the contradiction between the working class and its ideology, Mao Tse Tung Thought, and fascist bourgeois ideology, is antagonistic one and that McGill students have stood up and have commenced a war of annihilation against the enemies of the Quebec national liberation struggle, no matter where they be.

can befall the sons and daughters of the American working class and people!

The fascist authorities of Des Moines, along with the notorious FBI, are "making investigations" into these young comrades' heroic activities with a view toward stopping them. News from the bourgeois press frequently come to photograph the red flag and posters, but none of these photographs has yet reached the press -- only the FBI files. Even a Senate investigation committee has announced that it will "investigate" these comrades. The imperialists never cease to think that revolution is a conspiracy by a few people, and this is always their doom.

These comrades have carried out detailed work on the ideological front among the people. They attended a discussion group on black literature, for example, and called on the people there not to cultivate themselves and turn inward looking for a "black identity", but to study Mao Tse Tung Thought as the summation of the revolutionary experience of the world's people and the guide to action in making revolution. There was enthusiasm among the people for this call and many bought revolutionary literature from the comrades. When the universal truth of Marxism-Leninism-Mao Tse Tung Thought is integrated with the concrete experience of the Afro-American struggle in the United States, there will be no force on earth capable of preventing the victory of the anti-fascist revolution!

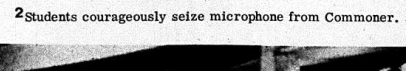

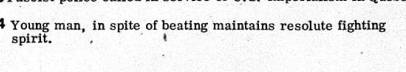
1 Imperialist agent Commoner was greeted by anti-imperialist placards.



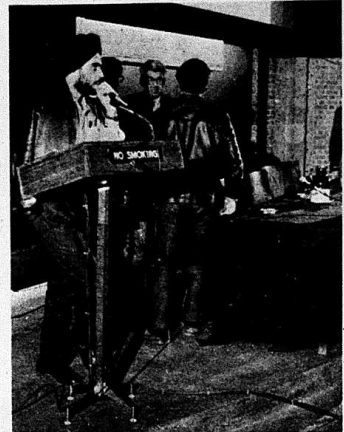
2 Students courageously seize microphone from Commoner.

Due to the militancy of these young comrades, standing up for the true aspirations of the Black people and the entire American working class and people, the fascist authorities of Des Moines have unjustifiably arrested two of them and charged them with "carrying concealed weapons".

When the "Call to Revolutionary Youth and Students" was issued on September 7th, these courageous Afro-Americans placed huge portraits of Chairman Mao inscribed with the slogan LONG LIVE CHAIRMAN MAO! in big letters in the windows of their headquarters and hoisted a big red flag out the window. These banners of the world's revolutionary people inspired the masses of Black People of Des Moines, and the young comrades went forth to sell large quantities of MASS LINE, theoretical organ of the ACWM (Marxist-Leninist) to them. For this they earned the undying hatred of the fascist authorities.

On Sunday morning, September 27, Peter Williams and Charles Smith were unjustifiably arrested and held without charge. It was several days before the fascist authorities could concoct a charge. No hearing date was set. Bond ransom was set at \$26,000 apiece. These outrages only further reveal the pactic of the fascists in the face of the wrath of the people and demonstrate their paper tiger nature for the whole world to see. To carry a weapon, concealed or openly, to use against the fascists is not a crime. It is the greatest honor that

Continued from page 1, column 5 students arrested in a campus disorder with offenses of a non-political nature in order to avoid controversy" (quoted in Victoria Times, June 16, 1970).

After having been arrested in such a manner, a comrade is then hauled in front of a kangaroo court and asked to plead "guilty" or "not guilty". When he takes a principled stand and denounces the court as lackey to U.S. imperialism, as traitor to the interests of the Canadian people, and as an active supporter of fascism, he is then sentenced to jail for "contempt of court". When he persists in his struggle to bring out the truth, he is removed from the courtroom and "tried" in absentia. It is a pre-requisite of the "trial" that he be found guilty. Police, judges and prosecutors,

These are the most hardened and vicious hired gangsters in the society, and will resort to any degeneracy to hide their shamelessness. They refuse to allow the truth about the nature of U.S. im-

These are all comrades who have received sentences of a month or more, some of which are still being served. Besides these, there were sentences handed out to comrades from Quebec, and numerous shorter sentences. Some of the people above have served more than one term.

The aim of all these arrests, threats and intimidations has been the futile hope of preventing the Canadian people from organizing to overthrow their oppressors. They hoped to prevent the development of a rising resistance movement among the working class and among oppressed sections of the youth and students. But as reactionaries everywhere have learned, reactionary and repressive violence only serves to escalate the people's struggles. Anti-imperialist sentiment is everywhere and is only waiting for a chance to seize initiative. The jails in particular are full of oppressed people who are held in confinement of the most barbarous kind for "crimes" that cannot begin to rival the crimes of their accusers.

An investigation of the jails shows that the vast majority of prisoners are from one or the other of Canada's exploited and racially-discriminated against national minorities. Native Indians make up a huge proportion of prison populations. At least 40% of inmates in Oakalla in B.C. are native Indians, held in jail on minor charges with high sentences imposed by racist magistrates. At Headingley Prison outside Winnipeg, 70% to 80% of the prisoners are Indians. All of these people have been brutalized and oppressed by the colonial system, harbour deep feelings of class hatred for their oppressors and are preparing to fight to the death for what is right and serves the oppressed people as opposed to what is wrong and serves the oppressor. They are a very determined element and firmly support proletarian revolutionaries who take a principled political stand against the police and courts. The prisoners have been for a long time aware that the prison system serves no-one except the exploiters. A recent struggle in the B.C.

Penitentiary where 300 prisoners selflessly braved the fire hoses, truncheons, and shotguns of RCMP sent out to suppress them in order to protest the callous mistreatment which led to the death of a native Indian inmate comrade, shows the strong feelings of solidarity that exist among prisoners, as well as their lofty opposition to racism. Struggles of a smaller scale were waged at Oakalla against the vicious prison conditions. Like the jails in New York, where the prisoners, led by militant black revolutionaries and Puerto Rican revolutionaries have waged fierce struggles, the Canadian prisoners are also bound to erupt like a pressure-cooker.

Wherever our comrades have been sent to prison, they have found people eagerly wanting to discuss anti-imperialist struggle and MAO TSETUNG THOUGHT. Revolutionary discussion groups have sprung up like mushrooms overnight in prisons all over Ontario. Patrick Sayers, a native Indian patriot who threw an incendiary bomb into the den of his and our people's oppressors at the House of Commons was in prison when comrades from the Communist Party of Canada (Marxist-Leninist) were arrested in April. He was struck immediately by the profound clarity of MAO TSETUNG THOUGHT and went resolutely to the court to denounce it. He made a statement in which he said that the native Indian people would unite with the Canadian working class and oppressed national minorities to overthrow their common enemy by armed force. Thus, he was placed in Penetang Mental Hospital for the "criminally insane". In spite of shock-treatments and forced drugs, he has remained utterly firm in his vow to remain loyal to MAO TSETUNG THOUGHT all his life.

At every prison where anti-imperialist fighters have been sent, the same has happened. Thus the authorities have resorted to three new degenerate and futile tactics:

1) move militant communists from one prison to another so that they get no chance to organize. This tactic up to now has had no success, since organization takes place almost immediately, and is only consolidated by the prisoners' recognition of the utter

bankruptcy of the authorities. 2) put fighters into solitary confinement. Release them from one section of the prison to another. Move them around frequently. These two methods only serve to put the comrades into contact with a wider number of persons who can organize themselves. 3) declare the prisoner "mentally unfit" and send him to a mental hospital.

All of these tricks only serve to expose the authorities more and to unite the prisoners in fighting them harder than ever.

Thus, wherever the imperialists turn, they are in a mess. If they leave the comrades alone, revolution develops rapidly, and if they attack the comrades, revolution develops rapidly also.

For a long time now, the police, the courts and the prisons have been used by the lackey bourgeoisie to threaten the people, along with their whole arsenal of social welfare agencies, and mental hospitals, etc. Conquering first their desire for a bourgeois career, and then step by step every other vicious threat of the imperialists, militant communists like Comrade Robert A. Cruise and Bill Shpikula have now torn down the second to last wall of defense of the lackey bourgeoisie, who are going increasingly into utter frenzy over what to do.

Oppressed prisoners have heard the news of the selfless struggles of the communists clear across Canada. Many are eager to unite with communists to carry out bitter struggles against their oppressors--prison authorities, courts, police and every other garbage of the society. By jailing communists and their supporters, the imperialists, far from stopping the struggle, have only unleashed upon themselves a new set of woes and brought themselves one step closer to their destruction.

Palestinian, Arab People keep attacking enemy



Baghdad, September 29 (Hsinhua) - Thousands of Iraqi people have come to the offices of Palestinian guerrilla organizations in Baghdad in the past several days to apply for admission to the Palestinian guerrillas so that they can fight shoulder to shoulder with Palestinian brothers at the front against U.S. imperialism and Israeli zionist and the reactionary forces in Jordan.

Handing in his application, young carpenter Abdul Hasni said: "U.S. imperialism and Israeli zionism have occupied our Arab land for decades. Now ferocious U.S. imperialism instigates the reactionary forces in Jordan to suppress and massacre our Palestinian guerrillas and Palestinian and Jordanian brothers. We demand to be sent right now to the front to fight U.S. imperialism and its lackeys. To die for safeguarding our revolutionary cause is a glorious death. I am ready to sacrifice myself in the fight against imperialism."

Young woman Luma Abdul Aziz said: "Palestine is part of our Arab land. To liberate the Arab Homeland from imperialism and zionism is the duty of our men, and women too."

Those fighters who have been enrolled are ready to go to the front.

New fighter by the name of Assad said: "Together with the Palestinian commandos, we will put up a resolute struggle to smash the imperialist, zionist and reactionary scheme against the Palestinian revolution and liberate every inch of our land from the clutches of U.S. imperialism and the Israeli aggressors."

Among the applicants, there were old people and school children. When these children were told that they were too young to be admitted, they would reply: "There are many 'Lion Cubs' as young as we are in the guerrillas. We want to go to the front as they do to fight against the yankee and Israeli zionists. We must defeat them and liberate our Arab Homeland."

When the application of an old man at the age of 60 was turned down several

times, he earnestly said to the office staff: "Give me weapons, I want to fight the enemy."

AL SAEQA

Damascus, September 29 (Hsinhua) When U.S. imperialism instigated the pro-U.S. reactionary Jordanian forces to suppress the Palestinian guerrillas, the latter, with the support of the masses of the Palestinian people have launched a series of attacks on the Israeli aggressors in the occupied areas.

The "Al Saeqa" commandos destroyed two Israeli skyhawks on the night of September 25 in an assault on the Gadis Airfield situated in the Houlah Plain in the Upper Galilee, according to a spokesman of the Central Committee of the Palestine Liberation Organization.

On the same night, the "Al Saeqa" commandos also shelled an Israeli military camp northeast of the airfield and destroyed several caterpillar vehicles in the camp. They also shelled an Israeli Officer's Club south of the Ras Elnaqua near the Mediterranean coast, scoring direct hits at the building and killing or wounding a number of Israeli officers.

On September 25, a unit of Palestinian commandos hurled a grenade at a group of Israeli troops on a street of Rafah City in the Gaza Strip, hitting four Israeli soldiers, according to a report of the daily "Fateh".

On September 22, the Palestinian commandos threw three grenades at the Israeli aggressors in Gaza City and attacked with machineguns several Israeli vehicles, in the Gaza Strip, inflicting heavy casualties on the enemy.

CHAIRMAN MAO TSETUNG STATEMENT OF MAY 20, 1970

A new upsurge in the struggle against U.S. imperialism is now emerging throughout the world. Ever since World War II, U.S. imperialism and its followers have been continuously launching wars of aggression and the people in various countries have been continuously waging revolutionary wars to defeat the aggressor. The danger of a new world war still exists, and the people of all countries must get prepared. But revolution is the main trend in the world today.

Unable to win in Viet Nam and Laos, the U.S. aggressors treacherously engineered the reactionary coup d'etat by the Lon Nol-Sirik Matak clique, brazenly dispatched their troops to invade Cambodia and resumed the bombing of North Viet Nam. The U.S. has aroused the heroic resistance of the three Indo-Chinese peoples. I warmly support the fighting spirit of Samdech Norodom Sihanouk, head of state of Cambodia. In opposing U.S. imperialism and its lackeys, I warmly support the joint declaration of the summit conference of the Indo-Chinese peoples. I warmly support the establishment of the Royal Government of National Union under the leadership of the National United Front of Kampuchea. Strengthening their unity, supporting each other and persevering in a protracted people's war, the three Indo-Chinese peoples will certainly overcome all difficulties and win complete victory.

While massacring the people in other countries, U.S. imperialism is slaughtering the white and black people in its own country. Nixon's fascist atrocities have kindled the raging flames of the revolutionary mass movement in the United States. The Chinese people firmly support the revolutionary struggle of the American people. In the war of resistance against U.S. aggression and for national salvation waged by the people of Viet Nam, Laos and Cambodia. The revolutionary armed struggles of the people of the South-East Asian countries, the struggles of the people of Korea, Japan and other Asian countries against the revival of Japanese militarism by the U.S. and Japanese reactionaries, the struggles of the Palestinian and other Arab peoples against the U.S.-Israeli aggressors, the national liberation struggles of the Asian, African and Latin American peoples, and the revolutionary struggles of the peoples of North America, Europe and Oceania are all developing vigorously. A weak nation can defeat a strong, a small nation can defeat a big. The people of a small country can certainly defeat aggression by a big country, if only they dare to rise in struggle, take up arms and grasp in their own hands the destiny of their country. U.S.S.R. nuclear monopoly and blackmail and that THE FORCE AT THE CORE LEADING OUR CAUSE FORWARD IS THE CHINESE COMMUNIST PARTY. THE THEORETICAL BASIS GUIDING OUR THINKING IS MARXISM-LENINISM. She stressed the significance of the GREAT PROLETARIAN CULTURAL REVOLUTION launched under the personal guidance of Chairman Mao, and its great contribution to Marxist-Leninist theory. China is building a socialist man, she said, a man who resolutely works for the majority of the people of China and the world over. She stressed the fact that China, a major world power, has no troops in any country and sticks strictly to Great Lenin's five principles of peaceful co-existence. She praised the fierce resistance of the three Indo-Chinese peoples and the vigorous struggle of the Palestinian and other Arab peoples as well as of the world's people in their just

struggle against U.S. imperialism. She praised the glorious struggle of the American people who are staunchly resisting Nixon's fascist atrocities right in the heartland of U.S. imperialism. She summed up her talk by quoting from Chairman Mao's May 20th Solemn Statement: NUMERABLE FACTS PROVE THAT A JUST CAUSE ENJOYS ABUNDANT SUPPORT WHILE AN UNJUST CAUSE FINDS LITTLE SUPPORT. A WEAK NATION CAN DEFEAT A STRONG, A SMALL NATION CAN DEFEAT A BIG. THE PEOPLE OF A SMALL COUNTRY CAN CERTAINLY DEFEAT AGGRESSION BY A BIG COUNTRY, IF ONLY THEY DARE TO RISE IN STRUGGLE, TAKE UP ARMS AND GRASP IN THEIR OWN HANDS THE DESTINY OF THEIR COUNTRY. THIS IS A LAW OF HISTORY.

Following this and the serving of a Banquet dinner, messages of solidarity were presented by various organizations present. Then the co-Chairman of the Ad Hoc Committee addressed the people. Without reser-

vation he said that China owed credit for all its great accomplishments to the infinite power of MAO TSETUNG THOUGHT. He said that before the revolution China was poor because of the exploitation and oppression of feudalism, bureaucrat capitalism and imperialist domination. 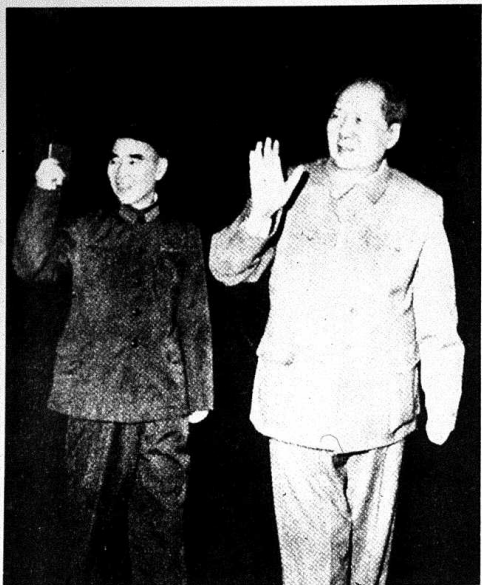

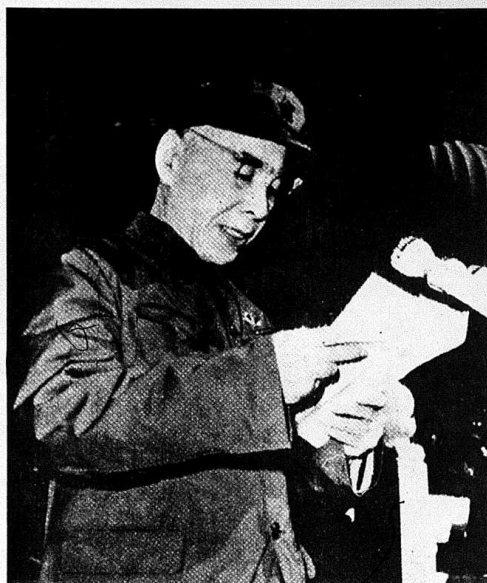
